This series of workshops provides a forum for the development and dissemination of applications of econometrics in health economics.

The workshop will follow the format of the long-running European Workshops on **Econometrics and Health** Economics, with a particular vision to: Promote health economics research with applied microeconomics focus in Asia; strengthen research network within the region; develop research network with other regions; and build on the research capacity of early-career health economists in Asia

The Workshop

The workshop program consists of up to 13 oral and 10 poster presentations. For oral presentations, each paper is allocated one hour, made up of a presentation by the author, followed by a response from a discussant and a general discussion. In the organized poster session, the author presents four 15-minute talks in front of a small group of audience. The number of participants will be limited to 50. Workshop participants will be expected to attend the whole of the meeting and play a role as either author, discussant, or chairperson.

The workshop will begin with a preworkshop dinner on Monday, Dec 16. In the Tuesday morning, we will have key-note lectures by: **Hanming Fang, University of Pennsylvania**

The workshop concludes at noon on Thursday, Dec 19, followed by an optional half-day tour to visit an old part of the city.
